



VIN Verification



All Used Motor Vehicles titled out-of-state including trailers weighing 2,000 pounds or more require a VIN verification. This can be accomplished by completing one of the following:

HSMV 82040, Section 8

OR

HSMV 82042

NOTE: ONLY a Division of Motorist Services Compliance Examiner is authorized to verify VIN for vehicles entering the country.
